

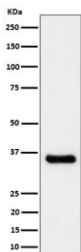

Description

Regulates CDK7, the catalytic subunit of the CDK-activating kinase (CAK) enzymatic complex. CAK activates the cyclin-associated kinases CDK1, CDK2, CDK4 and CDK6 by threonine phosphorylation. CAK complexed to the core-TFIID basal transcription factor activates RNA polymerase II by serine phosphorylation of the repetitive C-terminal domain (CTD) of its large subunit (POLR2A), allowing its escape from the promoter and elongation of the transcripts. Involved in cell cycle control and in RNA transcription by RNA polymerase II. Its expression and activity are constant throughout the cell cycle. [UniProt]

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the CCNH antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

A synthetic peptide derived from human Cyclin H/p34 was used as the immunogen for the CCNH antibody.

Storage

Store the CCNH antibody at -20°C.
