

Western blot analysis of lysate from KG-1 cell line using CD34 antibody diluted at 1:1000. Expected size is 40~110 kDa depending on glycosylation level.

Description

CD34 is a possible adhesion molecule with a role in early hematopoiesis by mediating the attachment of stem cells to the bone marrow extracellular matrix or directly to stromal cells. Could act as a scaffold for the attachment of lineage specific glycans, allowing stem cells to bind to lectins expressed by stromal cells or other marrow components. Presents carbohydrate ligands to selectins.

Application Notes

Titration of the CD34 antibody may be required due to differences in protocols and secondary/substrate sensitivity.

Immunogen

This CD34 antibody was produced from a rabbit immunized with a KLH conjugated synthetic peptide between 320-354 amino acids from the C-terminal region of human CD34.

Storage

Aliquot the CD34 antibody and store frozen at -20°C or colder. Avoid repeated freeze-thaw cycles.
