

Description

Collagen XVII, previously called BP180, is a transmembrane protein which plays a critical role in maintaining the linkage between the intracellular and the extracellular structural elements involved in epidermal adhesion. It is mapped to 10q25.1. This gene encodes the alpha chain of type XVII collagen. Unlike most collagens, collagen XVII is a transmembrane protein. Collagen XVII is a structural component of hemidesmosomes, multiprotein complexes at the dermal-epidermal basement membrane zone that mediate adhesion of keratinocytes to the underlying membrane. Mutations in this gene are associated with both generalized atrophic benign and junctional epidermolysis bullosa. Two homotrimeric forms of type XVII collagen exist. The full length form is the transmembrane protein. A soluble form, referred

to as either ectodomain or LAD-1, is generated by proteolytic processing of the full length form.

Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the COL17A1 antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

Amino acids KVFSAYSNTADLMDFFQTYGAIQ from the human protein were used as the immunogen for the COL17A1 antibody.

Storage

After reconstitution, the COL17A1 antibody can be stored for up to one month at 4°C. For long-term, aliquot and store at -20°C. Avoid repeated freezing and thawing.
