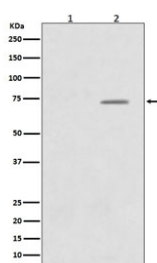

Description

Serine/threonine-protein kinase that acts as a regulatory link between the membrane-associated Ras GTPases and the MAPK/ERK cascade, and this critical regulatory link functions as a switch determining cell fate decisions including proliferation, differentiation, apoptosis, survival and oncogenic transformation. RAF1 activation initiates a mitogen-activated protein kinase (MAPK) cascade that comprises a sequential phosphorylation of the dual-specific MAPK kinases (MAP2K1/MEK1 and MAP2K2/MEK2) and the extracellular signal-regulated kinases (MAPK3/ERK1 and MAPK1/ERK2). Application Notes

Optimal dilution of the phospho-Raf1 antibody should be determined by the researcher.

Immunogen

A synthetic peptide specific to human Raf1 (surrounding pS43) was used as the immunogen for the phospho-Raf1 antibody.

Storage

Store the phospho-Raf1 antibody at -20oC.
